# Outline of Stockpiling



- **To meet the urgent need to address the challenge presented by the outbreak of avian influenza (H5N1), Japan contributed 1,500,000 anti-viral doses for stockpiling and 1,200,000 sets of Personal Protective Equipment for ASIA.**
- **This stockpile will be used for rapid containment according to the guidelines of the WHO.**

# Collaboration with ASEAN & ASEM



## For ASEAN

- 1million doses of anti-viral drugs (Half was stocked in Singapore, the other half was delivered to individual member countries)
- 700,000 sets of PPE (Half were stocked in Singapore, the other half were delivered to individual member countries)

## For ASEM

- Co-sponsor countries; Hungary, Republic of Korea, Laos, Mongolia, Pakistan, Singapore, Thailand & Vietnam
- Targeted Countries; ASEAN + India, Pakistan, China & Mongolia
- 500,000 doses of anti-viral drugs and 500,000 sets of PPE will be stocked in Singapore in the near future.
